
Competent Authority has decided to adopt the following as Para 2 of Rule 26 of STC Employees' (CD&A) Rules, 1975:

"In a case where the prescribed Disciplinary Authority is unable to function as the Disciplinary Authority in respect of any official, on account of his being personally concerned with the charges or being a material witness in support of the charges, the next higher authority in the schedule i.e the Appellate Authority will appoint an 'Ad-hoc Disciplinary Authority'. The Appellate Authority and the Reviewing Authority as mentioned in the Schedule of Authorities shall remain unchanged."

Accordingly, the Rule 26 after adoption of above Rule shall read as under:

"26. DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY

- 1) The Disciplinary Authority, as specified in the schedule, or any authority higher than it may impose any of the penalties specified in Rule 25 on any employee.
- 2) In a case where the prescribed Disciplinary Authority is unable to function as the Disciplinary Authority in respect of any official, on account of his being personally concerned with the charges or being a material witness in support of the charges, the next higher authority in the schedule i.e the Appellate Authority will appoint an 'Ad-hoc Disciplinary Authority'. The Appellate Authority and the Reviewing Authority as mentioned in the Schedule of Authorities shall remain unchanged.
